CYBER SECURITY SESSION

Date: 03 February 2026

A **Cyber Peace First Responder Programme** was conducted at **Sainik School Ghorakhal** on **03 February 2026** for the cadets and staff members of the school. The session was organised in the **online mode through a Zoom meeting** from **1100 hrs to 1250 hrs**.
