GUIDELINES ON ITEMS TO BE BROUGHT BY CADETS ON REPORTING

Dear Parents/Guardians,

As the new academic session is commencing, the following instructions are issued regarding the items to be brought by cadets at the time of reporting to the School. Adherence to these instructions will ensure uniformity, discipline, and smooth functioning of the residential system.

1. **Clothing and Personal Items**
 - (a) Summer Uniform – 02 sets
 - (b) Winter Uniform – 02 sets
 - (c) PT Dress – 02 sets
 - (d) House Dress – 02 sets
 - (e) Undergarments – 07 sets
 - (f) School socks – 06 pairs
 - (g) PT socks – 06 pairs
 - (h) Night dress – 02–03 sets
 - (i) Black formal shoes – 01 pair
 - (j) PT shoes – 01 pair
 - (k) Bathroom slippers – 01 pair
 - (l) Winter clothing and thermals (as required)
 - (m) Handkerchiefs – 06–08
 - (n) Towels – 02–03
 - (o) Lock with duplicate key
2. **Toiletries**
 - (a) Soap and soap case
 - (b) Toothbrush and toothpaste
 - (c) Hair oil and comb
 - (d) Shampoo
 - (e) Nail cutter
 - (f) Shaving kit (for senior cadets)
 - (g) Detergent
3. **Bedding**
 - (a) Bedsheets – 02
 - (b) Pillow covers – 02
 - (c) Blanket/Razai (as per weather)
4. **Books and Academic Material**
 - (a) Prescribed textbooks and notebooks
 - (b) Additional Book (Mandatory): Word Power Made Easy (for Class VI and IX new entrants)

5. **Items Strictly Not Permitted**

- (a) Mobile phones
- (b) Electronic gadgets
- (c) Hazardous items
- (d) Expensive valuables
- (e) Bulk/perishable food items


6. **Important Instruction Regarding Mobile Phones**

If a cadet is travelling alone and carrying a mobile phone for safety reasons, the same must be deposited with the Hostel Superintendent immediately upon reporting.

7. **General Instructions**

- (a) All items must be properly marked with name, class, and house.
- (b) Avoid sending unnecessary or valuable items.
- (c) School will not be responsible for loss of unauthorised items.
